### Purpose:


- To understand how the models perform in the overlap area

- In conjunction with other tools and data analysis, to assess use of the models to determine effects of current and projected levels of groundwater withdrawals




Phased Assessment Approach:

Determine groundwater availability


- First step determine potential for additional groundwater availability beyond current withdrawal amounts and distributions
- Solution development









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


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## **CFCA Work Plan**
