Lake Apopka

- Model review workshop #1 scheduled for Feb. 3 and Feb. 4 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the SJRWMD's Maitland Service Center. More info at <u>http://floridaswater.com/othermeetings/</u>
- MFL scheduled for 2017
- Lake Johns, Lake Apshawa South (re-evaluation), and Lake Prevatt (re-evaluation)
 - Stakeholder meeting to discuss CFWI review process planned for April/May
 - MFLs scheduled for 2018
- Wekiva River at SR 46 Bridge and associated springs (reevaluation)
 - HSPF model ongoing; Peer review process to begin in Feb
 - MFL scheduled for 2018



Lakes Clinch, Starr & Wales (Polk Co.)

- Reevaluation of MFLs scheduled for 2015
- Draft MFLs reevaluation reports completed and public workshops held in October 2015 (Starr & Wales) and December 2015 (Clinch)
- Final MFLs reports and rule amendments approved by the Governing Board on 12/15/2015 for initiation and approval of rulemaking



Lake Hancock (Polk Co.)

- Reservation scheduled for development in 2015 for water stored in the lake through the Lake Hancock Lake Level Modification project to aid recovery of upper Peace River MFLs
- Initiation of rulemaking reauthorized in July 2015
- Technical work is ongoing; rule development to be completed in 2016



Lakes Crooked, Eva and Lowery (Polk Co.)

 Crooked Lake MFLs reevaluation scheduled for 2016
Lakes Eva and Lowery* MFLs development scheduled for 2016

* Lake Lowery MFLs previously adopted by the SJRWMD



Other Priority Water Bodies (Polk Co.)

- Lakes Amoret, Aurora, Bonnet, Easy, Effie, Josephine, Little Aurora and Trout MFLs development scheduled for 2017
- Withlacoochee River System (3 middle/upper segments) MFLs development scheduled for 2020
- North and South Prong Alafia River MFLs development scheduled for 2021
- Peace River (3 upper segments) "intermediate" and "high" MFLs development scheduled for 2022
- Charlie Creek MFLs development scheduled for 2023
